### Modified Window Installation Policies for Aloha Lani


- 1. These policies reflect the installation of Makai (ocean-facing) windows in the bedrooms of the main tower "A-building". Any modifications to windows in the B-building, bedroom windows on the Ewa (west end) of the building or Mauka (mountain-facing) windows will not be approved at this time.
- 2. Two (2) acceptable specifications for installation are pictured in an attached drawing. Window layouts that differ from these specifications may not be approved.
- 3. All window frames must be clear anodized aluminum or vinyl. Vinyl framed windows must match the likeness of clear anodized aluminum.
- 4. 3/16" Tempered and 5/8" double paned glass are acceptable for use in installations detailed in the suggested specifications attached. Acrylic, and other materials substituted for glass are not approved for installation. The glass portion of the window installation may be clear, frosted or tinted using an approved film.
- 5. Window frames must be installed in a manner that does not damage or harm the structure of the limited common elements of the property. Anchoring deemed "excessive" will not be acceptable.
- 6. Aloha Lani's employees and/or Association of Apartment Owners will not be responsible for injury or damages caused by the failure or fault of a window installation contracted by an individual homeowner.
- 7. Any window installation that is not properly maintained or cleaned will be deemed non-compliant. Homeowners responsible for non-compliant windows will receive notification by way of violation notice or other written request by the Resident Manager. Homeowners shall clean and/or repair non-compliant windows within 14 days or become subject to a fine of \$10.00 per day until the situation is remedied.
- 8. Contractors and homeowners associated with the installation of a bedroom window are expected to comply with all applicable House Rules of Aloha Lani AOAO.
